At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "GENER" was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of Alicia, Isabela (16.8°N, 121.6°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h. It is moving Westward at 30 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

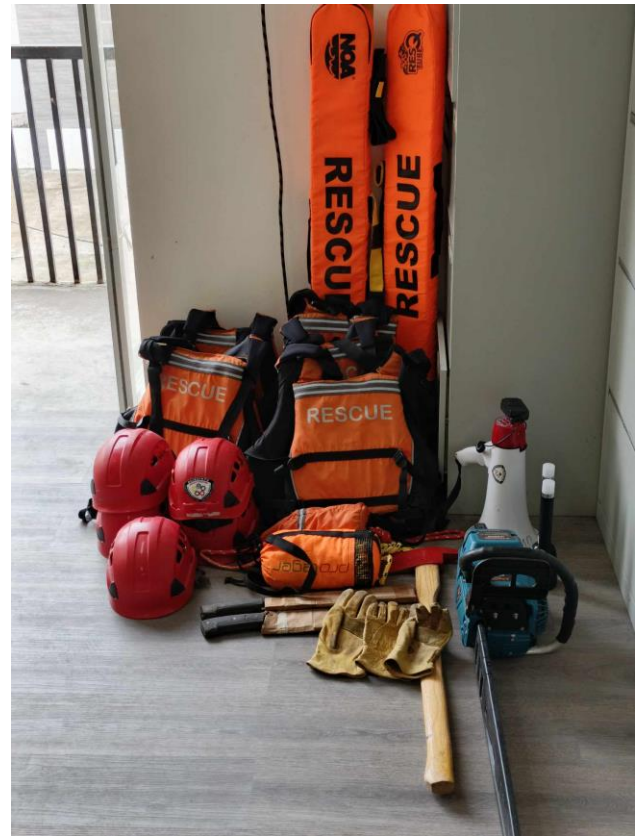

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "HELEN" {PULASAN} was estimated based on all available data at 1,155 km East of Extreme Northern Luzon (22.3°N, 132.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 105 km/h. It is moving West Northwestward at 25 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

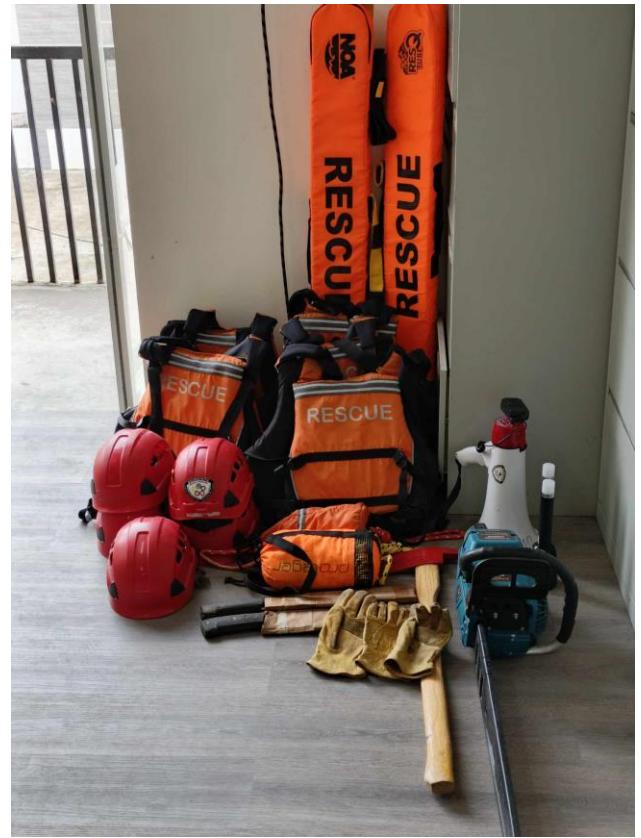

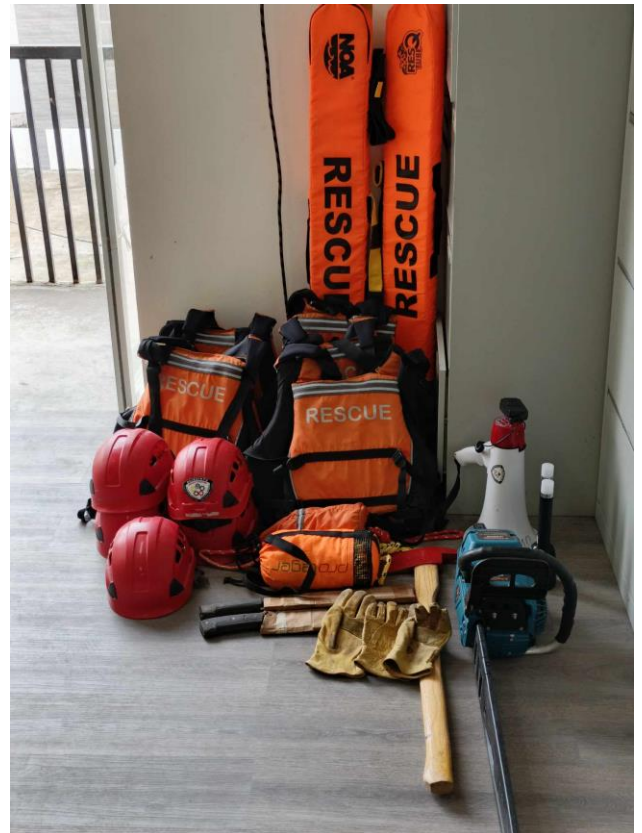
